Science Fair Schedule

10 a.m.	Registration. Participants may register and begin setting up their projects. Please report to SJND Kelly Gymnasium.
12 p.m.	Science Fair begins. Welcome and opening address, introductions of judges, overview of the day's events and activities.
12-1 p.m.	First round of project judging.
1 p.m.	Lunch Break on the SJND Quad. (Kelly Gymnasium is closed for judging.)
2 p.m.	First round results are posted.
2-3 p.m.	Second round of project judging. First Place Judging.
3:30 p.m.	Awards ceremony and acknowledgements.

Notes and Reminders

Each school must submit their Diocese of Oakland Science Fair School Participation form to SJND no later than **December 1, 2009**.

Each school may enter up to six projects (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade projects only).

Each school must provide one chaperone for every three students participating (1:3). No more than 2 chaperones per school. Chaperones will be responsible for overseeing and supporting the students representing their school throughout the competition.

Each school must submit the list of the participants' names and project titles by Friday, **February 12, 2010**. Please email your list to [jcosta@sjnd.org](mailto:jcosta@sjnd.org).

Each participant must submit the Student Registration form and pay the \$15 fee by **Friday, February 19, 2010**. Students should submit their registration form and money to the school's Science Fair contact person. Checks may be made out to Saint Joseph Notre Dame High School.
